

ACT/ETM PREP CLASSES

The Regional Office of Education, in cooperation with the school districts in ROE 27, is offering ACT Preparation Classes over a nine-week period in two locations. The new ACT preparation course that the Regional Office will be offering is through Education Testing Methods, Inc. (ETM) and is divided into nine weekly sessions. The registration and textbook fee for these classes is \$100. There is a minimum of 20 students per class and a maximum of 50. These classes will be offered Wednesday nights at the West Central School District. On Saturday these classes will be held in the morning in Aledo and in Monmouth in the afternoon (exact locations to be announced). You must mark on the registration form where you will be attending. *NOTE:* If you miss a class you can attend at one of the other locations. Listed below are the dates, locations and times.
